

Leaving Certificate 2021 - Candidate Self-Service Portal (Phase 2)

1. The **Candidate Self-Service Portal** for Leaving Certificate 2021 will reopen on **Tuesday 27 April at 12.00pm** and remain open **until Friday 30 April at 17.00**. This is to enable candidates to review and finalize the choices they have made for each subject.
2. Candidates should ensure the subjects listed on the Portal are correct.
3. Candidates should carefully review the level selections and consider whether you have opted for the correct level most suitable to you. Your teachers may have had discussions with some of you regarding the most appropriate level in their professional opinion. Students should consider this advice carefully.

Please also note the following information from the State Examinations Commission:

- The reopening of the Candidate Portal is the final opportunity for candidates to indicate the level at which Accredited Grades will be awarded.
- After the Portal closes, it will no longer be possible for either candidates or schools to change these levels as it will be too near to the start of the in-school process that applies to Accredited Grades. Schools will receive a final report following the closure of the Portal with final subject selections in advance of the commencement of the in-school phase of the Accredited grades process.

Candidates do need to consider their choice of level in each subject very carefully - if a candidate selects a level higher than that which they have been studying they may receive an estimated mark lower than that which they were expecting from their school.

Candidates who choose to sit the examinations will be allowed to change level on the day of the examination.

The SEC will provide further guidance for candidates in advance of Tuesday, which we will share with you as soon as it becomes available.
