## **LEAVING CERTIFICATE EXAMINATIONS 2021**

## **Key Messages:**

- 1. Candidates have been assigned to the same desk in the same exam centre, for the duration of the exams.
- 2. All desks will be 2 metres apart.
- 3. Candidates and superintendents must wear face coverings at all times. A candidate who fails to wear a mask will be refused access to the examinations.
- 4. Candidates must observe social distancing in accessing the centre, in the centre and on departure from the centre.
- 5. There will be attention to hand hygiene to reduce the risk of transmission.
- 6. Candidates are required to have their own pens, calculator etc.
- 7. Candidates are not allowed to have mobile phones, personal music players, tablets, smart watches, or other unauthorised electronic devices with them in the exam centre, whether switched on or off.
- 8. When the exams begin, the candidates should stay within their examination centre pod. This includes before, between and after examinations.
- 9. There is no alternative sitting of the Leaving Certificate in 2021. The safety net of Accredited Grades has been put in place.

## **Restrictions on Candidates presenting for exams:**

Leaving Certificate candidates who have made a choice to sit examinations want to be able to exercise that choice for the month of June. If candidates act without due care, it could mean that they and/or their friends do not get to sit their exams due to COVID-19.

Candidates should limit their interactions with others and avoid gatherings that present risks of COVID-19.

Candidates will not be allowed to present for exams in the following circumstances:

- They have been diagnosed with COVID-19
- They are unwell or have symptoms of COVID-19
- They have been instructed to self-isolate or restrict their movements
- They are a close contact of a confirmed case.

## **Attendance at Exams:**

- 1. Day 1: Wednesday 9<sup>th</sup> June: Candidates are required to be in their assigned seat in the exam centre at least 30 minutes before the start time of the exam (and 15 minutes on subsequent days).
- 2. Candidates must present in full uniform for all exams.
- 3. A candidate who is late for an exam will be admitted up to 30 minutes after the start time, but the time is forfeited.
- 4. If the candidate is going to be absent from an examination or a number of examinations, parent/guardian or the candidate must contact the school so that the superintendent of the exam centre is notified at the earliest opportunity.
