## 1<sup>st</sup> Year Christmas Exam Guidelines 2022

## **GENERAL INFORMATION**

- All exams will take place in the students' base classroom.
- Students are required to **ATTEND SCHOOL AS NORMAL** from 8.50am until the end of school day.
- •It is expected that all students who do not have a scheduled exam, study in their classroom where the quiet and ordered environment will be of great benefit.
- All students should **BE IN YOUR DESIGNATED SEAT AT 8.50am**. The day begins with a roll call by your Class teacher.
- For the duration of the exams, on Monday to Thursday LUNCH will be at the normal time of 1.10-1.50pm and break will be from 10.55-11.10. On Friday lunch will be from 11.00 to 11.30.
- There are 2 exams scheduled for 1<sup>st</sup> year students each day. Students have normal timetabled classes in the afternoons except for Friday when students have one exam before break and one exam after break.

## **EXAM GUIDELINES**

- MOBILE PHONES SHOULD NOT BE USED DURING AN EXAM or STUDY PERIOD. All mobile phones should be switched off and placed in your bag; this applies to all exams & study periods. Make sure you have a hard copy of all notes you require for study.
- **TOILETS** should be used **BEFORE** each exam session; they may only be used during the exam in case of absolute necessity.
- To ask a question, be excused for the toilet or if you require additional paper, please **RAISE YOUR HAND AND WAIT FOR AN INVIGILATOR TO COME TO YOU** you should not leave your seat.
- Students that have prohibited materials or **ATTEMPT TO CHEAT** in an exam will have their exam cancelled.
- There is **NO COMMUNICATION** permitted, or attempts at communication of any type between students during an exam or study session. Students who attempt to communicate may have their exam cancelled.
- It is important that students **FOLLOW ALL INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY** when submitting exams at the end of sessions do not leave your seat or attempt to communicate with another student until all exams are collected.
