


Vision of Junior Cycle








Assessment Task (A.T) – worth 10% - written response

Assessed by State Exams Commission


*some subjects WILL NOT complete an A.T; instead will complete a practical component

Summative Assessment (S.A) Grading System – written exam:

Assessed by State Exams Commission

- Distinction (90-100%)
- Higher Merit (75-90%)
- Merit (55-75%)
- Achieved (40-55%)
- Partially Achieved (20-40%)
- Not Graded (0-20%)
