FLOOD RELIEF SCHEME

Dear Residents and Business Owners,

28/02/2024

I would like to inform you about the upcoming section of works as part of the Glashaboy Flood Relief Scheme, including works for the realignment of the Hazelwood Junction.

Starting tomorrow morning, **Thursday 29th February at 07:00**, Sorensen will commence works from the junction at Hazelwood/R639, heading East on Hazelwood Road – L-2699, towards Brooklodge, shown in **BLUE** – Fig One.

To ensure the safety of pedestrians and motorists during these works, a new traffic management plan will be implemented from **7am tomorrow morning** and will consist of:

1. Stop/Go operatives located on the R639 on the north and south bound carriageway. As shown in **RED**
2. A third Stop/Go operative will be positioned on the lower side of the Supervalu entrance to manage the traffic flow. As shown in **RED**
3. Additionally, to facilitate the safe movement of pedestrians, the existing pedestrian access will be temporarily relocated to the area highlighted in **YELLOW** in the image below.

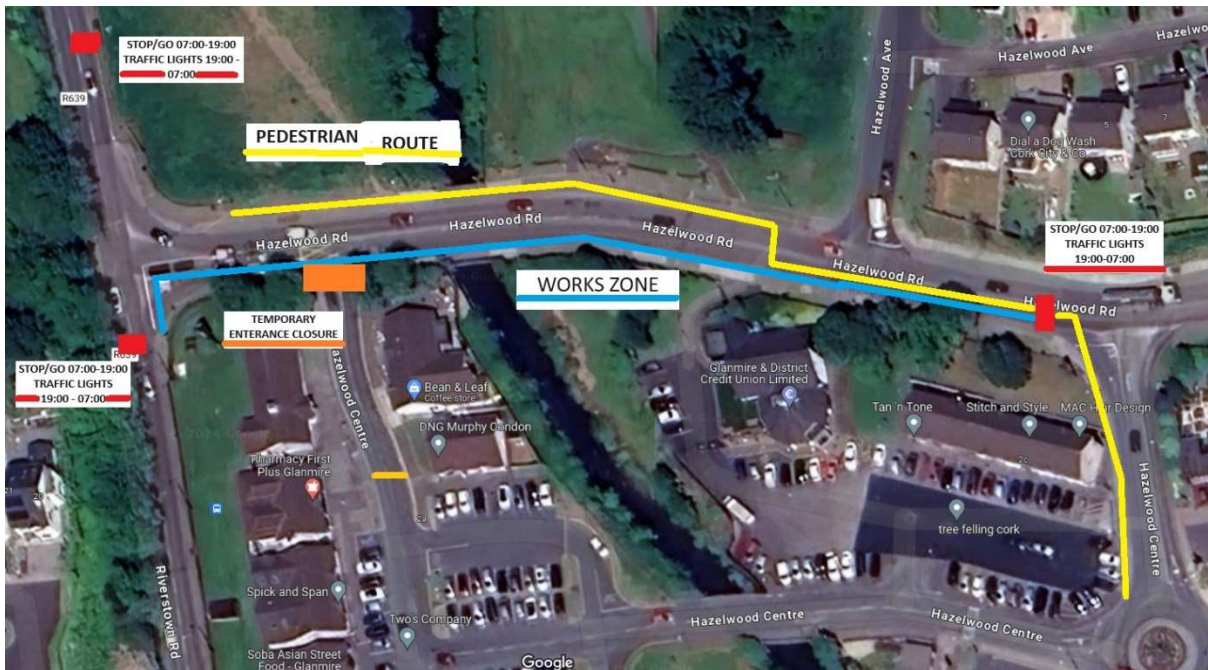
Due to this new traffic management layout, it will be necessary to **temporarily** close the lower entrance to Hazelwood Shopping Centre at Bean & Leaf. As shown in **ORANGE** – Fig One. This closure is essential to ensure the safety of all road users and pedestrians and to facilitate the smooth flow of traffic during the works period.

We will maintain full access to the Hazelwood Shopping Centre via the Supervalu entrance.

Business will continue as normal for all businesses in the Hazelwood Shopping Centre, where there is a fantastic range of businesses and ample parking available.

Considering the new traffic management system being implemented, we kindly ask you to plan your journey accordingly. It is advisable to leave extra time for your commute, especially tomorrow morning, as we transition to the new traffic management layout. Alternatively, if feasible, please consider using an alternative route to minimise any potential delays.
